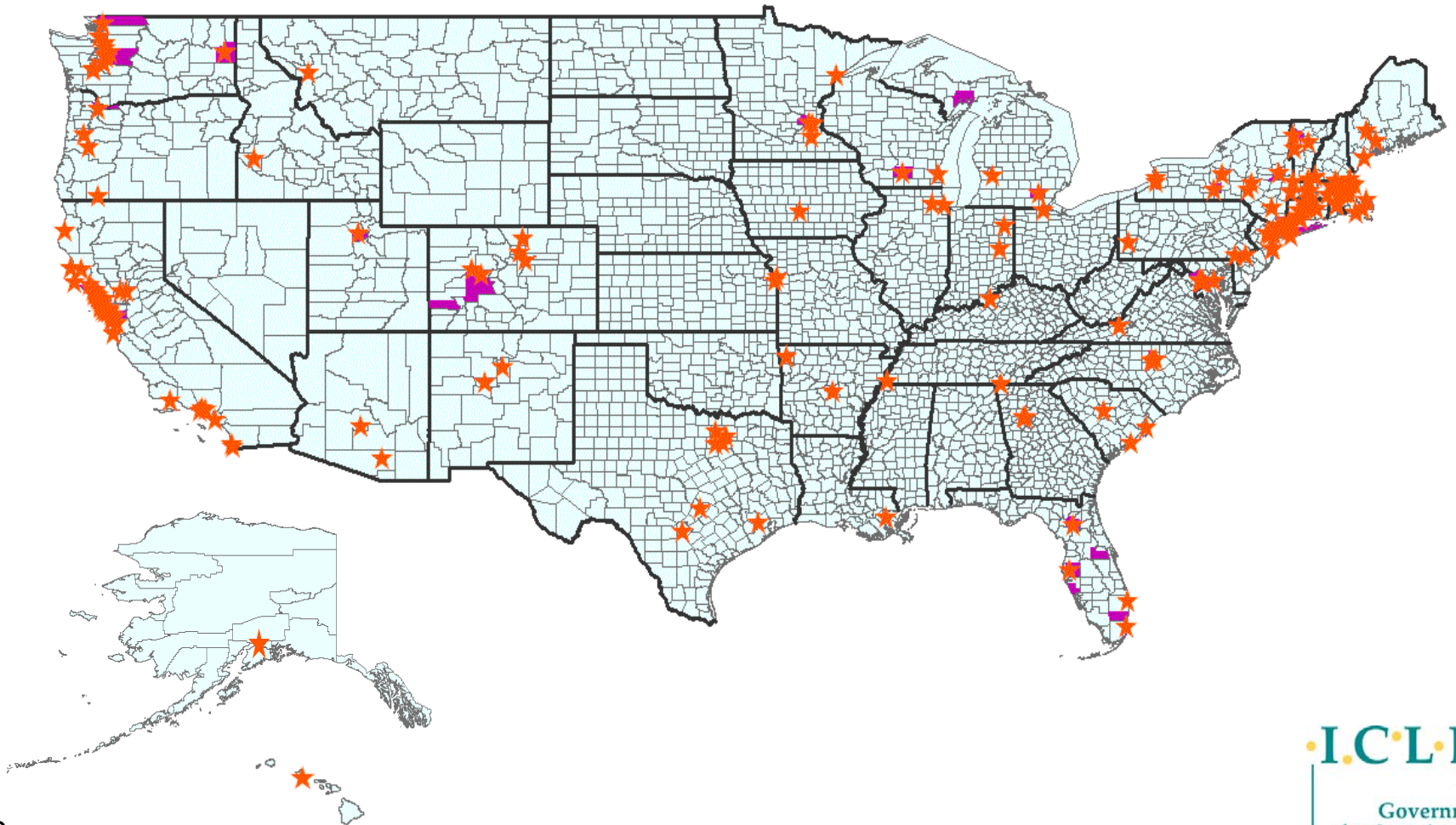

ICLEI's Cities for Climate Protection (CCP) Campaign



Annual Results from CCP Participants

Cumulative local actions have a positive impact on global climate change.

- 23 million tons of eCO₂ reduced
- \$535 million saved in fuel costs
- 4 million MWh of electricity savings
- 74 million gallons of gasoline savings

States Can Support Local Govt Climate Protection Efforts

State agencies and local governments can both win by addressing climate protection goal-setting, planning, and implementation together.

- Collaborative climate action planning
- State/regional transportation & land use planning
- Clean energy generation planning / utility regulation
- Energy-efficient building & appliance standards
- Environmentally preferable purchasing collaboration
- Vehicle emissions standards
- State-wide GHG emissions cap or renewable portfolio standards
- Direct project implementation
- Awareness raising, recruitment, convenings
- Intentional inter-governmental dialogue
